

LG Mobile Goes 3D

LG unveils its first 3D smartphone at Mobile World Congress-- the Optimus 3D.

The handset's 4.3" 3D touchscreen carries glasses-free 3D-- with the effect extending to the UI, using the set's applied parallax barrier technology. It also allows users to record 3D video (via 2 cameras on the back), and an included Youtube 3D video app allows for easy content uploading.

Inside the set is a dual-core 1GHz TI OMAP 4 chip, together with a PowerVR SGX540 graphics chip. Meanwhile Android is the OS of choice.

It also carries a number of connectivity options, including HDMI and DLNA.
