Never let it be said Samsung is a slouch when it comes to new devices-- it shrinks down the Galaxy S4 to 4.3-inch and announces a duo of Galaxy Tab 3 tablets at Computex 2013.





Aimed at mid-tier customers, the Galaxy S4 mini is smaller than the original 5-inch Galaxy S4, even if it remains bigger than the 4-inch iPhone 5. It packs an 8MP rear-facing camera, 8GB storage, 1.5GB RAM and a 1.7GHz processor.

The OS of choice is Android 4.2.2 (Jelly Bean) as skinned with the usual variety of Samsung apps.

This is not the first time Samsung shrunk down a flagship smartphone-- on October 2012 <u>Samsung revealed a mini (and somewhat dumbed down) version</u>

of the 4.8-inch Galaxy SIII, reportedly due to demand for smaller devices from the European market.
