Battery-case maker Mophie outs a new kind of product at CES 2014-- the Space Pack, the first case packing local built-in iPhone 5/5s storage as well as the regular rechargeable battery.



"Many people know Mophie as a mobile battery company, but our primary goal is built on the idea of allowing our customers to do more with their mobile devices; to make accessories that are more than just functional and fashionable, but are truly smart accessories," the company says. "Users that buy a Mophie product can really do more with their phone or tablet. The battery is at the heart of that. Any user that owns a mobile device can't do any thing with it without power."

On the outside the Space Pack looks near-identical to the earlier Juice Pack Air, if with a shiny metal power indicator button and a micro USB port for hooking to Macs or PCs and charging. The battery is a 1700mAh number, while storage comes in either 16 or 32GB sizes.

Handling storage management duties is a Space app complete with file playback and support for iOS 7 apps such as Photos and Mail. It also features import/export to camera roll a sync option for entire library backup.

Mophie is currently taking Space Pack preorders, with shipments kicking off from March 2014.
